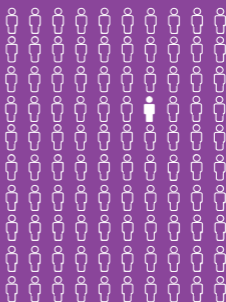


What is epilepsy?

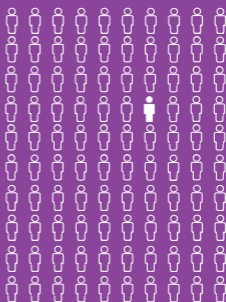
